

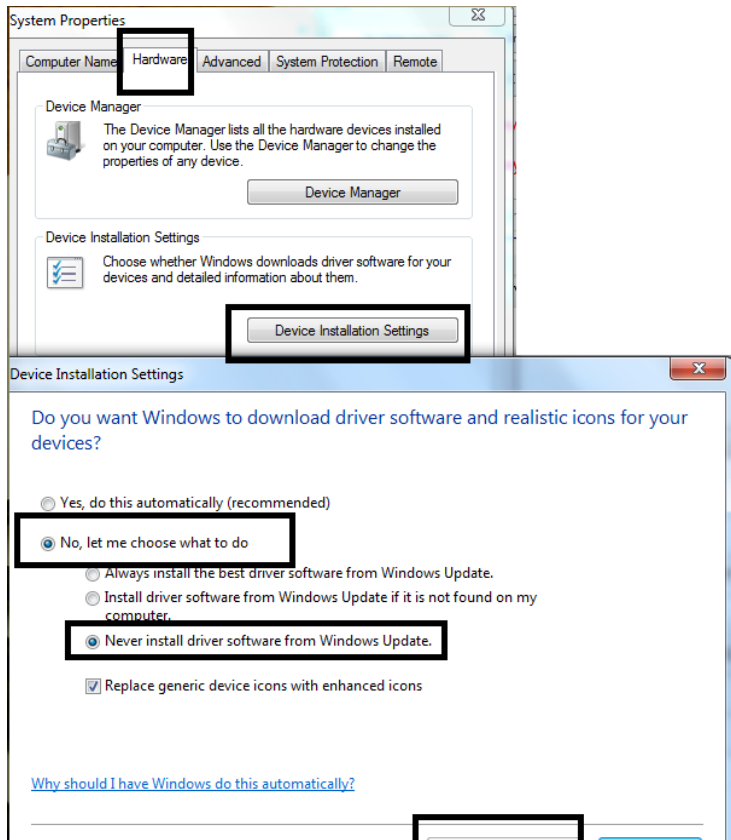
Possible issues with USB and Windows 7

You **might** run into an issue with Windows 7 trying to load its own driver for the USB, what you need to do **first** is:

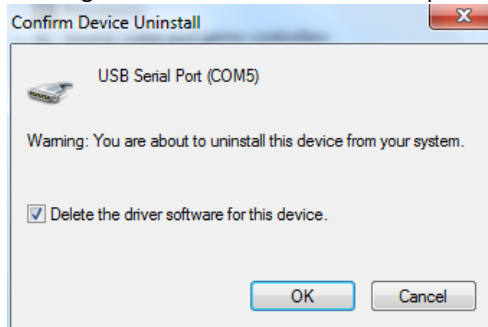
Go into Control Panel / System:

Click Advance system Settings / Hardware / Device Installation Settings

In device installation settings click no let me choose what to do, never install driver software from Windows Update save changes.



You might need to uninstall the comm port and the driver software then unplug then plug in the USB cable.



Then plug in the USB cable to the reader. Should come up with a Communication port in device manager.

Use that communication port to register the unit. Go to Network, register via Server, pick the com port and scan.
